BYLAW No. 03-2013

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 3-2001, TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189 TO ESTABLISH A DISTRICT FIRE DEPARTMENT BY AGREEMENT

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 3-2001, being a bylaw to provide for entering into an agreement with the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 to establish a district fire department by agreement, be amended in the following manner:

1. Replace Schedule C, "Fire call out fees" with the following
