

BYLAW NO. 04-2015

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC BYLAW NO. 11-2010

The Council of the Town of Lumsden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

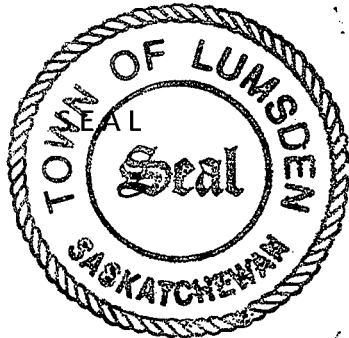
That Bylaw No. 11-2010, known as the Traffic Bylaw, be amended in the following manner:

1. APPENDIX 6 is amended by adding the following:
 "7. **Fourth Avenue** On the north side between James Street North and River Street."
2. Replace Section 4(c)(1) with the following:
 "No person shall, except where authorized by resolution of Council or when duly authorized by law, erect immediately adjacent to any highway; any sign, marker, signal or light or any advertising sign or device."
3. That Bylaw 01-2011 is hereby repealed.

Effective Date

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of its passing.
