MINUTES OF THE DEVELOPMENT LEVY BYLAW NO. 08-2016



- Impose and provide for the payment of development levies;
- Provide consistency between development levies and subdivision servicing fees, where appropriate;
- Authorize agreements to be entered into in respect of payment of development levies;
- Set out the conditions upon which the levy will be applied to specify land uses, classes of development, zoning districts or defined areas; and
- Indicate how the amount of the levy was determined.

Mayor Bryan Matheson declared the public hearing open at 7:30 p.m.
