

TOWN OF LUMSDEN
BYLAW 04-2017

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9-2001, BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF DOMESTIC WASTE AND OTHER REFUSE

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 9-2001 as follows:

1. Remove Appendix B and replace it with the following:

APPENDIX "B" to BYLAW NO. 09-2001
SCHEDULE OF LANDFILL TIPPING FEES

The Landfill Tipping fees stated below apply to all Users who are not Approved Municipal or Commercial Haulers (see Appendix "A" of Bylaw 9-2001).

MIXED LOADS	
Pickup Truck or Small Utility Trailer	\$ 20.00 per load
1 Ton Commercial Truck or Large Utility Trailer	\$ 40.00 per load
2 Ton Truck & Over	\$120.00 per load
*Special Services Fee	\$250.00 per load

SCRAP TIRES	
Passenger Car or Smaller	\$10.00 per tire
Truck or Semi-Trailer	\$15.00 per tire
Agricultural Equipment	\$15.00 per tire
Mining Vehicles/Equipment	\$50.00 per tire
Tires with Rim	\$15.00 per tire

Mixed Loads include the following waste:

- Household waste that is not contained in bags
- Carpet, Sofas, Furniture, Mattresses, Burning barrels, etc.,
- Bulk refuse (incl. Concrete mixed with wood, metal or plastic rubble),
- Shingles and insulation,
- Dead animals -\$15.00 per animal (buried in trench and covered immediately). Service Available to small animals only, livestock carcasses prohibited
- Wood, metals and recyclables that are not sorted for disposal in specified designated areas
- Wood that is not clean of nails, contaminants, etc.
- Items with Refrigerant (fridges, freezers, etc.) - \$10.00 per item
- Propane Tanks - \$10.00 per tank

The Town, through the Public Works Foreman, Landfill Attendant or their designate, reserves the right to refuse permission to deposit any part of or all of the refuse brought to the Landfill Site, if, in the judgment of the Public Works Foreman, the material in question does not meet the requirements specified in Bylaw 9-2001.

WASTE EXEMPT FROM TIPPING FEES:

- Bagged waste shall be allowed into the Landfill Site at no charge,
- Lawn and garden vegetation shall be allowed into the Landfill Site at no charge,
- Recyclables, such as clean wood and metal, sorted and disposed in specified designated areas at the site shall be allowed at no charge.

***Special Services Fee:**

The special services fee may apply to any user or hauler, at the discretion of the Public Works Foreman or their designate, when waste being disposed by a user or hauler requires special attention from the Public Works Department.

2. That Bylaw No. 01-2015 and 14-2013 are hereby repealed.

3. Effective Date

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of its passing.
