

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN No. 189

BYLAW NO. 14-2015

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON A PORTION OF GRID 641 AND A PORTION OF GRID 734

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions:

(a) "highway" means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area; as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, 2004.

(b) "motor vehicle" means a vehicle propelled or driven by any means other than by muscular power; as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, 2004.

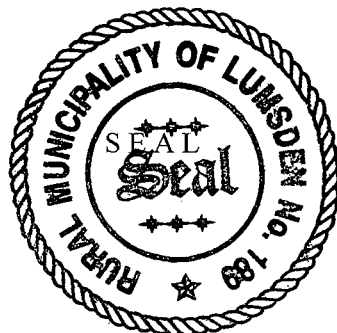
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 60 km per hour on the Grid 641 highway, commonly referred to as the "Pense Grid", from the most westerly highway boundary of the Town of Lumsden and ending at the most westerly end of the property located within the Town of Lumsden boundary in the NW 29-19-21-W2.
- 3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 60 km per hour on the Grid 734 highway, commonly referred to as "Old No. 11 Highway", from the most easterly boundary limit of the Town of Lumsden to the intersection of Grid 734 and the road allowance located along the WNW 27- 19-21-W2.
- 4. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
- 5. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of its passing.
