

TOWN OF LUMSDEN

Bylaw No. 04-2016

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 11-2010 known as the Traffic Bylaw of the Town of Lumsden.

The Council of the Town of Lumsden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 11-2010 as follows:

1. Section 4. INFRACTIONS, subsection (f) PARKING, clause (7) is deleted and replaced with the following new clause and subclause:

(7) "Subject to subsection (i) No person shall park a vehicle on a highway at one place for any period of time exceeding twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.

(i) Privately owned and fully licensed recreation camper trailers may be parked on the street in residential areas from April 1 to October 31 of each year, provided that they are parked adjacent to the owner's property and parked for a period not to exceed seventy-two (72) consecutive hours."

2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final approval of Council.
