BYLAW NO. 2011-02

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPROPRIATION OF LAND LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS THE UNREGISTERED ROAD WAY THROUGH NE 1-20-21-W2

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

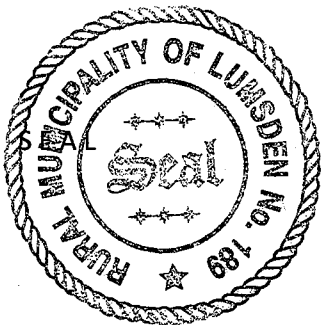
- 1. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 deems it necessary to acquire title to the unregistered roadway through the NE 01-20-21-W2 for the purpose of providing legal access to landowners of the NW 6-20-20-W2 and cannot do so by agreement with the landowners.
- 2. It shall be lawful for Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 to expropriate the said property; and to proceed in accordance with the provisions of *The Municipal Expropriation Act*.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.
