MINUTES OF THE GROUP II COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD ON JULY 7, 2015

The Group II Committee convened their committee meeting in the Lumsden Municipal Office, on the afternoon of Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 3:50 p.m. with Chairperson Randy Bogdan presiding.

The Committee met to discuss plans for the relocation of the recycling centre up to the landfill.

Landfill/Recycle Relocation

Concept of Area:

- The Committee discussed the possibility of the addition of a 2nd entrance to the landfill that would allow for an open concept and access to the recycle centre at all times. The existing single entrance will continue to be used and re-evaluated if needed
- The Committee felt that a wood chipper would be a beneficial purchase for Council to consider in a future budget

Hours of Operation:

- Committee discussed ways to discourage people from dropping off garbage on the days the landfill is closed
- It was felt that the majority of the material at the existing recycle depot is dropped off on Saturdays
- Landfill current hours were reviewed. Currently Mondays at the landfill are quiet so the Committee suggested closing Mondays but opening up the landfill on Fridays


Building/Compactor:

- Councillor Grohs suggested that piles under the cement pad for the building would be a good investment. Jeff will find out what the engineers recommend for piles and obtain price quotes to report back to the Committee.
- The foundations for both the building and the compactor will be completed this year, as well as the power extension for the compactor. Piles likely won't be required under the slab for the compactor
- Jeff to inquire whether or not a lean-to on the proposed building would be suitable to meet the storage criteria of recycled electronics
- Discussed an area for people to drop off re-usable items and an awning system that would cover these items
- Community Living and other similar organizations could be contacted to pick up unclaimed items that are re-usable, after a certain period of time
- Recyclable materials can be co-mingled in the compactor
- The Electronics, paint, gas recovery, staff washroom, staff lunchroom all to be located within the new building
