The Lumsden Town Council convened their regular meeting in the Council Chambers of the Town Office, on the evening of Monday, June 8th, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. with Mayor Verne Barber presiding.

186-09 MacKay/Sulma: “That the minutes of the May 25th regular meeting be approved as circulated.” **CARRIED**
