**Transportation:**

- 10 Fawn Ridge – flooding, but remains Guy Johns' responsibility
- 240 – 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue – Judy Kehler would like the Town to pay her or a contractor to repair the damage caused by Public Works' snow removal. She doesn't want Town employees to repair the damage to the Kehler's rock garden although the employees are able to complete the work. There is still a tree and sprinkler head to be fixed. Town employees have already fixed the rocks and put wood chips in to match what was there. The area was viewed by Councillor Phillips and she couldn't see any difference between the two sides. Judy wants a written response from Council.
- James Street South
  - For 3 years, road has not been maintained because of dust control.
  - Last year, 1 application of canola was used for a cost of \$10,000.
  - Need to grade, put on gravel and pack it before the dust control is used.
  - Plan to do road work in the next 2 weeks, dust control in June.

**Sewer:**


- Lagoon – new aerator motor, 3 running now.
- SK Watershed Authority (SWA) closed the dam at Craven. Wetland filled up so Town employees can't pump lagoon out. They had wanted it down to reduce odour.
- Need to send letter to SWA requesting that they inform stakeholders when doing something like this and ask that they provide 2 weeks notice of their plans to allow us time to prepare. It would have back flooded 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue if Jeff had not closed the screw gate late one evening.


**Capital Planning:**

- Grant application was completed for Esso Park. Total budget of \$25,600. TD grant portion of \$10,000 and Town of Lumsden capital portion of \$7,000
