- Fees: Recommendations made and will be taken to council

- items remaining for the kitchen total \$2125. Chris to speak to Wayne about getting these done

**Ball Diamonds:**

- Minor ball will be upgrading the fencing
- bleacher boards will be replaced this year
- Canteen is operational but space can't be rented for May/June as Minor ball has it stocked

**Esso Park:**

- No response on funding yet
- we need to get a new name
- Chris to talk to Wayne about getting the money allocated back into the budget

**Town Sign:**

- Chris suggested the use of the big sign in the new Esso park as a landscape piece
- Chris and public works have been working on ways to enhance the other smaller signs
- a new sign for the Lumsden entrance is a priority
- Beautification committee will take over the flowers in the sign bed for 2010

**Trails:**


- installation of the kiosks to start in May, weather depending
