BYLAW 12-2010

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 08-2005, BEING THE PUBLIC NOTICE POLICY BYLAW.

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 08-2005, being a bylaw respecting public notice policy, be amended in the following manner:


1. Replace Section 3.1(j) and Section 4(1) with the following section:
 3.1
 (j) setting the date for Council or Committee meetings, which are not regularly scheduled meetings, or in the case when a special meeting or committee meeting is called to address an emergency or pressing issue and all members of Council sign a waiver of notice, where required by legislation.

- 4.1 Notice shall be given to the general public for all matters set out in subsection 3.1 (a to q) in accordance with this section:
 - (a) notice of the matters shall be posted at the Municipal Office at least seven (7) clear days prior to the meeting at which Council will initially consider the matter (except for meetings called pursuant to section 3(j)); and
 - (b) notice of the matter agenda shall be posted:
 - on the municipal web site,
 at least seven (7) clear days prior to the meeting at which Council will initially consider the matter.
 - (c) for all meetings called pursuant to section 3.1(j) notice of the matter shall be posted at the Municipal Office at least one (1) clear day prior to the meeting at which Council will initially consider the matter posted:




