#### **Environmental:**

#### **Transportation:**

- Sidewalk contractors have been told we want them completed in spring Work will start with 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue
- Replacing sidewalks would likely take all of the budget this year
- Trees are being removed from main channel, trees will be removed from the toe of the dyke next
- We have 1700 sandbags filled
- An amendment to motion is needed so that filled sandbags will be \$1.00 to Lumsden or RM residents only

#### Water and Sewer:

- Pump is back cost more to be refurbished than had been anticipated: \$11,400.00. This pump is to be used for storm sewers and drainage and at the lagoon as well
- We have applied for provincial flood funds but haven't heard what we are getting yet
- We will rent pumps under this program
- Associated Engineering will approve projects that should be done to prepare for flooding and location to be pumped from – they will pass this along to SWA in a 2 page report
- SWA will pay for expanding the Oxbow River
- We will get permission from John Reitmeier for Clifton to drill adjacent to the existing lagoon to characterize the Valley Bottom
- Sampling for AE for new wastewater plant is being done. pH meter and DO probe purchased and are being used at the sewage at lift station
- Chris is working out fine

- Bryan is going to meet with Darcie re: Jeff and Dave's salary steps and then will meet with Jeff and Dave.
