- The James Street Bridge has been resurfaced
- There was a landfill inspection yesterday, it is in compliance
- Most of the large public works projects are complete, students are finished for the summer
- An area behind the skating rink has been paved
- The builders of the new town sign are waiting on the engineered drawings for the foundation of the sign before it can be installed
- Storm drains for the James Street South Local Improvement Project were discussed. Dave will be speaking with the engineers to determine where the run-off water will be directed. Repairs to hydrants will be done prior to the paving of the road
- The new truck was picked up and the box is being installed
- Public works will be scraping out the rock in front of the post office soon

Environment:


- An environmental compliance inspection of the lagoons was conducted yesterday, the lagoons are in good shape and all works are in compliance
