A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PROCLAIM ANY DAY OR PART OF ANY DAY EXCEPT SUNDAY TO BE A CIVIC HOLIDAY

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary from time to time to declare a certain day or a part of a certain day to be a civic holiday in the Town of Lumsden;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Mayor of the Town of Lumsden is hereby given authority to proclaim

The day following Christmas Day or the day which is observed as Boxing Day as a "Civic Holiday" in the Town of Lumsden.

2. Bylaw No. 6/73 is hereby repealed.
