A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN TO ALLOW STORES TO REMAIN OPEN  
ON HOLIDAYS



WHEREAS the Legislature has, by the enactment of The Urban Municipality Amendment Act, 1988, delegated to municipalities control over the hours of opening of stores;

AND WHEREAS Section 121 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 (as amended) enables Council to allow stores to open on holidays.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Town of Lumsden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows: -

1. In this Bylaw, all words and expressions shall have the same meaning as contained in The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 as amended from time to time.
2. All stores may remain open on any day that is a holiday.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of passing.
