

BYLAW NO. 2/91

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN TO REGULATE AND
PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression "Town" shall mean the Town of Lumsden.
2. Subject to section 3, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearm, air-gun or spring gun or any class or type thereof within the Town.
3. The provisions of section 2 do not apply to a person who is
 - (a) a police officer.
 - (b) a registered member of a gun club or similar organization while engaged in target practice at a recognized range.
 - (c) a person to which a special permit has been granted at the discretion of Town Council.
4. The Administrator of the Town is hereby authorized to issue a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization who makes application for such permit stating specifically the intent of such club or organization and the location of their range along with a permit fee of \$10.00.
5. The Administrator of the Town is hereby authorized to issue a special permit to a person designated by resolution of Town Council stating specifically the intent and location specified by such resolution.
6. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town.
7. Bylaw No. 3/71 is hereby repealed.


