TOWN OF LUMSDEN

BYLAW NO. 1-96

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT OF STATUTORY,
WAGE, UTILITY AND PRE-AUTHORIZED ACCOUNTS**

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Mayor and Administrator are hereby authorized to pay the following statutory, wage, utility and pre-authorized accounts when they become payable:
 - a). *Remittance due to the Buffalo Plains School Division No. 21;*
 - b). *Accounts due to the Saskatchewan Power Corporation;*
 - c). *Accounts due to Saskatchewan Energy;*
 - d). *Accounts due to Sask. Tel and Sask. Tel Cell Mobility;*
 - e). *The Town of Lumsden Payroll for employees;*
 - f). *Accounts due to the Receiver General for Canada;*
 - g). *Accounts due to SUMA with respect to the Group Insurance Program;*
 - h). *Remittance due to the Municipal Employees Superannuation Commission;*
 - i). *Council remuneration and indemnity due;*
 - j). *Accounts due in respect of actions previously authorized by resolution of Council, including but not limited to travel, convention, workshop, and similar account expenses.*
2. Accounts paid pursuant to this Bylaw shall be submitted to Council at its next regular meeting following the payment of the said accounts.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and be in effect on the final passing thereof.
