

- Council agreed to have another meeting to offer the position to Don Barnett on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday of the following week at 10 a.m. depending on availability.
- Council agreed to contact Earl Inverarity about returning to work April 1st, one month before his leave of absence expires
- Jim Hipkin indicated that Tom Turnbull may be willing to assist the new PW Manager
- Councillor Szeles discussed the idea of a municipal logo decal on the RM truck and requested that there be a reporting system put in place for personal use of the vehicle.
