Jim Hipkin, Reeve announced that the public hearing is being held to rezone certain lands in the SW 5-19-20-W2, consisting of approximately 63 acres located slightly southwest of Highway 11 near the south boundary of the municipality.

There were 2 verbal and no written submissions presented.

Terry Daly attended the hearing and had some questions regarding the rezoning from the Agriculture zone to Low Density Valley Residential zone and questioned who was responsible for providing services to the proposed area.

Shannon Ternial, from Deer Valley, attended the hearing and questioned the impact that creating 3 new parcels have on the environment, wildlife and their habitat. She wondered if council considered this in their decision process. She also indicated her concern over possible increase in snowmobile usage from the creation of these parcels.

Loney Anderson attended the hearing to answer any questions that anyone attending the public hearing may have regarding his proposed development.
