

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189

BYLAW NO. 21-2018

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 13-2018, KNOWN AS "THE DEER VALLEY TRAFFIC BYLAW", A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES WITHIN THE ORGANIZED HAMLET OF DEER VALLEY.

The Council of the R.M. of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 13-2018, as follows:

1. **SPEED**

a) **Subsection 5 (b)** is deleted and replaced with the following:

"No person shall operate a vehicle at a speed greater than eighty (80) km/hr on the road known as "Deer Valley Road" from the east entrance of the Organized Hamlet of Deer Valley, to 500 meters west of the east entrance."

2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final approval of Council.

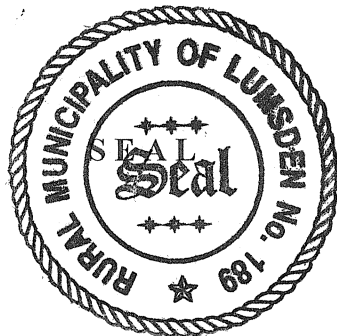
