- 3. Compliance with the signage regulations from Section 4.10 of the Zoning Bylaw;
- 4. Compliance with the parking requirements from Section 4.17 of the Zoning Bylaw;
- 5. Submission of a parking plan prior to the commencement of each phase of development;



- 6. Compliance with the landscaping requirements from Section 4.17 of the Zoning Bylaw, including the submission of a landscape plan and execution of a landscaping declaration;
- 7. Compliance with the outside storage and garbage storage requirements from Section 4.19 of the Zoning Bylaw;
- 8. The installation of any new plumbing and sewage systems shall be permitted, inspected and approved by the Saskatchewan Health Authority;
- 9. The onsite wastewater system must be installed in accordance with the Saskatchewan Onsite Wastewater Disposal Guide;
- 10. The Plumbing Regulations and The Private Sewage Works Regulations are adhered to;
- 11. Prior to the construction of any new property access approach, an application first must be made and approved by the RM of Lumsden No. 189;
- 12. Verification of the groundwater supply via a hydrogeological assessment or approved alternative;
- 13. All outdoor on-site lighting shall be located, oriented and shielded so that no direct rays of light: are directed at any adjoining properties, interfere with the use of and enjoyment of neighboring lands, interfere with the effectiveness of any traffic control devices or the vision or safety of motorists, or produce any unnecessary light pollution; and
- 14. A road development agreement executed prior to the second building permit being approved." CARRIED

- 4. The installation of any new plumbing and sewage systems shall be permitted, inspected and approved by the Saskatchewan Health Authority;
- 5. Execution of a Servicing Agreement, including the requirement to pay a development charge in the amount of \$20,124.17;
- 6. Payment of \$4,000.00 cash in-lieu of municipal reserve dedication;
- 7. Payment of the \$500.00 multiple parcel commercial/industrial subdivision application fee:



8. The construction of a Heavy Haul/High Volume Service Road with a width of 30 meters, that will run adjacent to the frontage of S½ 6-20-21-W2, in accordance with the specifications from the RM of Lumsden No. 189 Road Servicing Agreement Policy and the recommendations/comments from the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure; and

9. Adherence to the comments from the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure's July 11, 2018 letter respecting the subdivision."
