

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189

Bylaw No. 01-2015

A BYLAW TO PERMIT OPERATING UNREGISTERED GOLF CARTS ON HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE UNORGANIZED HAMLET OF DEER VALLEY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELLING TO AND FROM A GOLF COURSE.

Subject to and in accordance with s. 113.1 of *The Traffic Safety Act* and *The Registration Exemption and Reciprocity Regulations, 2014*:

THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the "Unorganized Hamlet of Deer Valley" means the residential subdivision legally located in Section 7 and Section 08, Township 19, Range 21 West of the 2nd Meridian as described in Appendix "A".
2. It shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart during the hours between one-half hour prior to sunrise and one-half hour after sunset on all public highways within the limits of the unorganized hamlet of Deer Valley, in the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 strictly for the purposes of travelling by the most direct route between a golf course and the storage location of the golf cart.
3. No one shall operate a Golf Cart in the unorganized hamlet of Deer Valley unless they hold a valid Class 7 driver's licence or higher.
4. The Golf Cart shall display a slow moving warning device as prescribed in *The Vehicle Equipment Regulations(1987)* with one side parallel to and not less than 300 millimetres nor more than 1200 millimetres from the ground.
5. The owner of the Golf Cart must insure themselves and every other person who, with the owner's consent, operates that golf cart, against liability imposed by law arising out of the ownership, use or operation of that golf cart and provides proof of insurance at the request of a peace officer.
6. Golf Carts must be operated in accordance with the rules of the road in *The Traffic Safety Act* and any other municipal bylaw related to traffic.
7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by Saskatchewan Government Insurance.

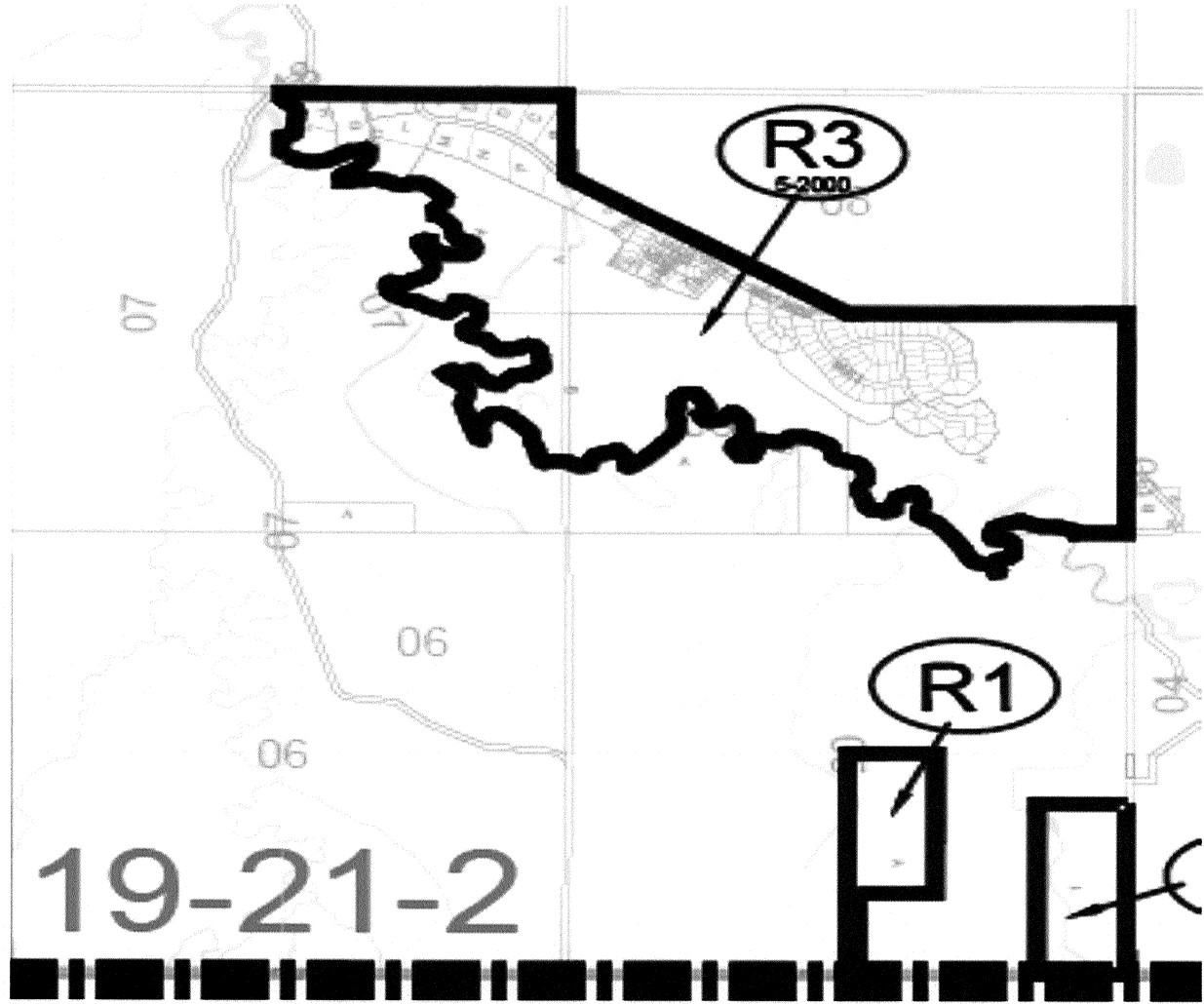

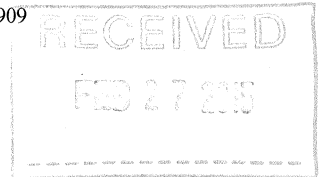
