RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189

BYLAW NO. 14-2014

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 6-2012, known as the Official Community Plan of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 6-2012 as follows:

1. **Section 6.0 MINIMUM SEPARATION REQUIREMENTS 6-1 Separation Distances Between Uses** is amended by deleting the number "600" applicable to the separation distance between Waste Management – Liquid facilities and all other uses and substituting the following number: "457"
2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by the Minister of Government Relations.
