Lindsey Sawatsky, General Manager at Sunroof, stated, "We are very pleased with the installation. The 10kW solar system will generate approximately 15,000-kilowatt hours of renewable energy each year, which is 54% of River Park Centre's yearly electricity usage. Over the next 20 years, River Park's carbon footprint will be reduced equivalent to burning approximately 120 tonnes of coal or 25,000 gallons of gasoline."

Bryan Matheson, Mayor of the Town of Lumsden said, "We are excited about participating in the Municipal Solar Power Program offered by Sunroof. With Sunroof's solar system, our kilowatt per hour cost for renewable solar electricity is less than what we are currently paying, and we anticipate overall savings of approximately \$21,000 in electricity expenses at the River Park Centre over the lifetime of the system."
