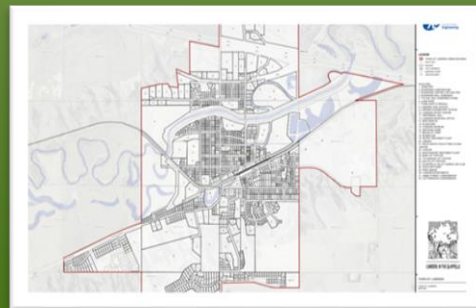


# ABOUT LUMSDEN

## NEED TO KNOW

### RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SCHEDULE

Tuesday mornings - **north** of the railroad tracks  
Thursday mornings - **south** of the railroad tracks

### RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Crown Shred pick-up dates are every **second Thursday** morning (see the town website for specific dates).  
\*\*\*PLEASE\*\*\* refer to the town website to learn about acceptable recycling materials.

### LANDFILL INFORMATION

The Lumsden Solid Waste Facility is open from Wednesdays to Saturdays (varying hours). A recycle compactor and reuse center is also on site. Please see town website for specific hours and fees.

### PRAIRIE VALLEY SCHOOL DIVISION

Lumsden has an elementary school with a French immersion option, as well as a high school. Both schools are located on Broad Street. Please see town website for more information.

### COUNCIL MEETINGS

Town Council meetings are generally held twice a month, every **2nd** and **4th Tuesday** evenings at 6:30pm, with some exceptions. The location of meetings is currently dependent on COVID-19 regulations. Please contact the town office to determine location.

## RECREATION

### LIBRARY

The Lumsden Library branch belongs to the South East Regional libraries. Located on 3rd Avenue next to the Sports Centre, check out a book today! (306) 731-BOOK.

### LIONS PARK

### LUMSDEN HISTORICAL MUSEUM

Located on Qu'Appelle Drive West, the Lumsden Historical Museum is in operation from May to September.

### OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

The Summer of 2021 will bring with it Lumsden's first ever off-leash dog park located behind Lumsden's Heritage Home just off Broad Street.

### QU'APPELLE VALLEY NORDIC (QVN) SKI CLUB

### SPECIAL EVENTS

Lumsden Duck Derby is an annual fundraising event held every Labour Day long weekend. Generally hosted at River Park (weather dependent). Don't forget to buy your ducks!  
The Scarecrow Festival. Display your scarecrows to celebrate in the fall festivities. Held the third weekend in September.

### CENTENNIAL HALL

This beautiful and historic building hosts several community activities and weddings. Located on 3rd Avenue, it is the perfect venue to book for your next gathering.

### LUMSDEN SPORTS CENTRE

Home to a range of hockey programs, as well as figure skating, and curling. Next door to the Sports Centre is a full-sized outdoor skating rink in the winter and a skateboard park in the summer.

### CHURCHES AND FAITH BASED VENUES
