In Lumsden, Mayor Verne BARBER was acclaimed. We had 7 candidates running for 6 positions. 4 Incumbents were returned to office (Councillors Ron HART, Sid SIKORSKI, Al SULMA and Gerry TOMKINS) and 2 Councillors newly elected – Councillor Dan KIRBY and Wayne MACKAY. 209 voters cast their ballots representing approximately 20% of the eligible voters.
