**TRANSPORTATION**

**Sidewalks:**

- From 8<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> on James Street, look great
- Need to back fill between the street and the sidewalk and some places need to be reshaped
- Book contractors for Aril 15, 2011
- Need to start a process to determine how sidewalks will be built where there currently are none
- Look into building sidewalks as a local improvement
- Consider sidewalk on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue going over new storm sewer and paving & widening at the same time. Could this be considered a local improvement?

**James Street South:**

- Jeff will look into street lights for James Street South, not safe for youth walking on that road
- There should also be a walkway

**Cottonwood Place Runoff:**

- Tom from AE will give a cost estimate on a solution for the spring runoff on Cottonwood Place
- We need to know if a bylaw was contravened by moving water off a private lot

**ENVIRONMENT**

**Landfill:**

- Jeff submitted a written report with regard to the Manager of Landfill Operations course he attended Nov 15-18
- Jeff will look into using asphalt shingles to cover household waste instead of burying shingles in a hole
- Complaints have been received about people going through garbage bags at the landfill

**Summer Students:**

- Suggest a longer rotation so students can do other jobs besides just cutting grass

**Esso/Cottonwood Park:**

- No parking will be allowed
- Park plan and planting should be complete by the end of April
- Work can be done by summer students

**Cemetery:**

- Plan to begin plant at the beginning of May
- Summer students can assist with this
- Plan needs to be in place by before May
- Someone needs to follow up with Mr. Ramsay

**WATER & SEWER UTILITY****Fire Hydrant:**

- Will be putting in a new fire hydrant at the end of Ross next Monday
- Hydrants isn't sealing, nor is the valve in front
- Replacement will only take one day

**Lagoon:**

- Lagoon is accepting 600 L<sup>3</sup>/day, based on the flow meter
- Look into a water conservation building code or bylaw for the legislation of low flow toilets and backflow preventers on water lines
- Check that black flow preventers are required on sewer lines
- Eliminate permission to discharge sump pumps into sanitary sewers

**Waste Water Treatment Plant:**


- One of the filter pumps at Drinking Water Treatment Plant is being fixed and will need to be replaced in the next 2 to 3 years, estimated cost is \$10,000 to replace the pump

**Infrastructure Replacement Sequencing:**

- Lift Station on 7<sup>th</sup> avenue, consider for GoGreen, SRC grand funding
- Consider preliminary geology for another well
- GoGreen/SRC finding possibilities: lighting in the shop, centennial hall and furnace at Centennial hall
