A BYLAW TO GOVERN DIRECT SELLERS

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 in the Province of Saskatchewan.

Pursuant to the provisions of The Direct Sellers Act, 1965, the council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 enacts as follows:

Any person who carries on the business of a direct seller within the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 shall pay to the said municipality the fee prescribed by the regulations under the Direct Sellers Act.
