Amendments: BYLAW TO PREVENT THE PLOUGHING AND ENCUMBERING OF ROADS

No. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189,
of the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "plough" shall mean any implement used for the breaking of soil and/or for snowplowing;
 - (b) "municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 of Saskatchewan;
 - (c) "road" shall mean any road allowance within the municipality other than:
 - (i) a private road, or
 - (ii) a provincial highway.
2. No person shall plough any road or portion thereof within the limits of the municipality.
3. No person shall encumber any road in the municipality with a vehicle, building or other article or thing.
4. Notwithstanding Clause 2, municipal employees and other persons authorized to plough roads in the municipality shall be exempt from the provisions of this bylaw.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 10/59 passed on March 16, 1959 is hereby repealed.
