

**R.M. OF LUMSDEN NO. 189  
BYLAW NO. 03-2010**

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH  
PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS**

The Council of the R.M. of Lumsden No. 189 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

**1. SHORT TITLE:**

This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".

**2. DEFINITIONS:**

"Municipality" means the R.M. of Lumsden No. 189.

**3. ENFORCEMENT:**

Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.

**4. PENALTY:**

Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:

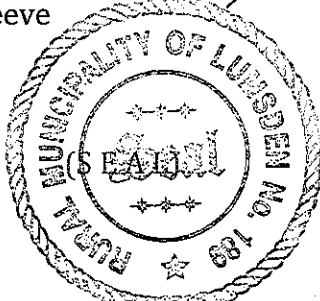
- a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
- b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.

**5. COMING INTO FORCE:**

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of its passing.
