

BYLAW NO. 8-2014

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 6-2012, known as the Official Community Plan of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 6-2012 as follows:

1. **Section 6.0 MINIMUM SEPARATION REQUIREMENTS Table 6-1 Separation Distances Between Uses** is amended by adding the following words after the words "Multi-lot Country Residential" in the category for "Residential":
"or urban municipality"
2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by the Minister of Government Relations.
